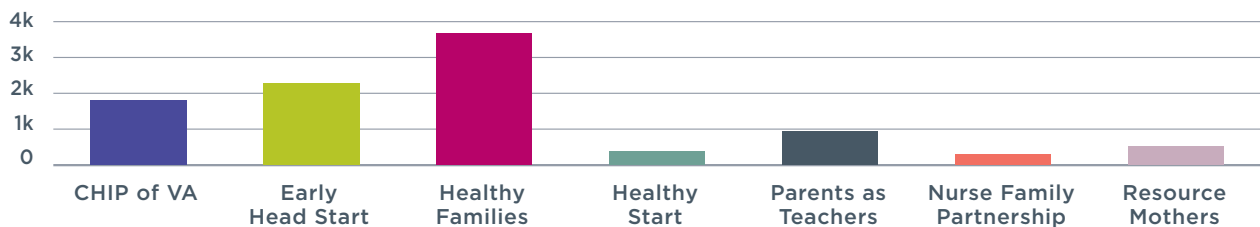


Virginia's Seven Unique Home Visiting Models Served 9,875 At-Risk Families in 2018

JLARC report highlights effectiveness of home visiting and opportunity to support Early Impact's role to strengthen the field.

December 2017

General Assembly invests \$850,000 of TANF funds over two years to strengthen Early Impact as the home visiting umbrella organization.

July 2018

COLLABORATION

Early Impact and Virginia Department of Health develop new partnership to co-lead multimillion dollar MIECHV grant.

October 2018

Early Impact dedicates full-time position to strengthening partnerships across the state through the Alliance for Early Childhood Home Visiting.

August 2018

INNOVATION

Early Impact develops new print and digital public awareness materials to increase awareness and enrollment in home visiting programs across the state.

January 2019

Work begins to establish shared indicators and develop a statewide data system for reporting.

EXCELLENCE

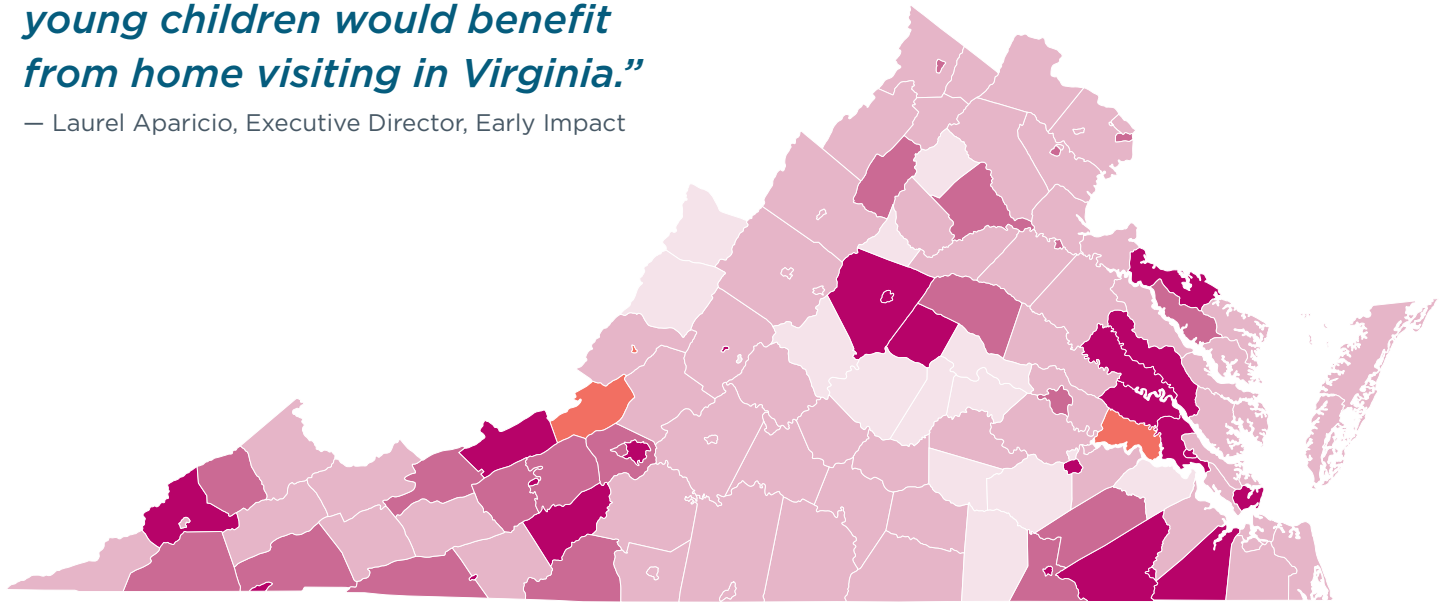
